5. Placement Requirements			
The skip bin must be placed as close to private property as possible.			
The skip bin cannot be placed on Council's roadway or across a concrete or bitumen formed footpath under any circumstances.			
There must be a distance of 1.2m between the skip bin and the kerb and gutter.			

The skip bin must be made visible at night so it can be seen by pedestrian and motorist.

6. Declaration by applicant

I hereby make application to use the Road Reserve as detailed above and agree to all conditions required by Council under the Roads Act 1993 and/or the Local Government Act 1993. I understand that I am responsible for the cost of repairing any damage caused to the roadway as a result of works carried out under this approval, whether the damage was caused by me or by an agent acting on my behalf.

I confirm that prior to the commencement of the works; a Public Liability Insurance Policy with a minimum cover of \$10 million in relation to the occupation of Councils road reserve, for the full duration of the works will be obtained.
