CONDITIONS

Skip bins / Containers / Storage Units may be placed upon the roadway under the following conditions:

- Containers may only be left by companies or individuals who hold a current approval/receipt from Council.
 Approval is not transferable for day(s) or location and an approval/receipt should be carried by the applicant and produced if required.
- The Applicant is responsible for ensuring that public liability insurance is in place to the value of \$20 million dollars.
- Containers must be visible at all times (e.g. marking plates, reflective tape, flashing lights).
- Containers must be placed parallel to the road, must comply with the NSW Road Rules 2014 and must not be placed where parking is prohibited for motor vehicles.
- There is a minimum pedestrian access of 2 metres clearance on a footpath or vehicle access of 3 metres clearance on a roadway.
- It does not obstruct vehicular traffic entering or leaving premises or interfere with the sight lines of, or visibility to, drivers/vehicles, cyclists or pedestrians entering or leaving premises or create risk or injury to persons.
- It does not restrict access to any service that may be contained in the road reserve. The supplier should contact the relevant utility company if they are unsure whether the placement of the container will cause any risk of injury to person or property or inconvenience to the public.
- Containers may not be used for the for the disposal or storage of putrescible, inflammable or explosive materials. If containers have bungs, all bungs must be fitted and capable of preventing the escape of material.
- Containers shall bear the name and telephone number of the supplier.
- Suppliers are responsible for any incidents or damage resulting from poor placement of containers or spilt debris and agree that the area will be left in a clean and tidy condition with all spillage removed from the area.
- The supplier shall be responsible and accept responsibility for any damages or injury resulting from debris from the building waste container during transport.
- Council reserves the right to order the removal of any container, despite any approval granted, and issue a fine if it deems warranted should a container or the activity associated with it cause a nuisance.

Any containers which do not comply with these regulations are to be placed within private property.
